

## 2007-2008 GATEWAY CHESS LEAGUE ACTION TOURNAMENT

DATE – The tournament will be played on Saturday, February 23, 2008.

PLACE – The tournament will be played at Westminster Christian Academy, 10900 Ladue, Saint Louis, Missouri, 63141.

REGISTRATION – Tournament registration will be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. Advanced registration is recommended. To register, go to [www.gatewaychess.org](http://www.gatewaychess.org) and follow the instructions. The deadline for advanced registration is 6:00 p.m., Friday, February 11. **If you pre-register, you must still be present for registration from 8:00-8:30am or late fees will apply.**

ELIGIBILITY – All students in kindergarten through grade twelve are eligible. Schools may not enter teams in sections that include grades higher than the highest grade in the school that the team represents.

HIGH SCHOOL DIVISION FORMAT – The tournament will be played in six rounds at 9:30, 11:00, 12:30, 2:00, 3:30 and 5:00. Students in grades nine through twelve are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. The school score is the sum of the four highest player scores. Four school trophies and four individual trophies per grade will be awarded. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Players will be paired with players in other divisions.

NINTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – The tournament will be played in six rounds at 9:30, 11:00, 12:30, 2:00, 3:30 and 5:00. Students in kindergarten through grade nine are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. The school score is the sum of the four highest player scores. Two school trophies and four individual trophies per grade will be awarded. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Players will be paired with players in other divisions.

EIGHTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – The tournament will be played in six rounds at 9:30, 11:00, 12:30, 2:00, 3:30 and 5:00. Students in kindergarten through grade eight are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. The school score is the sum of the four highest player scores. Two school trophies and four individual per grade will be awarded. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Players will be paired with players in other divisions.

SIXTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – The tournament will be played in six rounds at 9:30, 11:00, 12:30, 2:00, 3:30 and 5:00. Students in kindergarten through grade six are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. The school score is the sum of the four highest player scores. Two school trophies and four individual trophies per grade will be awarded. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Players will be paired with players in other divisions.

FIFTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISIONS FORMAT – The tournament will be played in six rounds at 9:30, 11:00, 12:30, 2:00, 3:30 and 5:00. Students in kindergarten through grade five are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. The school score is the sum of the four highest player scores. Two school trophies and four individual trophies per grade awarded. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Players will be paired with players in other divisions.

RATINGS – United States Chess Federation Ratings will be used where possible. Grade twelve students without ratings will be assigned a rating of 800, grade eleven students without ratings will be assigned a rating of 750 and so forth.

AWARDS PRESENTATIONS – Awards presented at 6:30. No awards will be presented before this time.

UNITED STATES CHESS FEDERATION – United States Chess Federation membership is required for tournament participation. Players must either show proof of membership or purchase membership at the tournament. The cost for players under twenty-five years of age is \$25.00 for one year membership and subscription of CHESS LIFE. The cost for players less than sixteen years of age is \$19.00 for one year membership and six issues of CHESS LIFE. The cost for players less than thirteen years of age is \$13.00 for one year membership and six issues of CHESS LIFE FOR KIDS.

ENTRY FEE – The on time entry fee is \$10.00 per player. The entry fee for players who begin registration after 8:30, or who pay the cashier after 9:00 is \$12.00. **If you pre-register, you must still be present for registration from 8:00-8:30 am or late fees will apply.** Checks must be written to INTERSCHOLASTIC CHESS.

TIE BREAKERS – Ties will be broken using the SOLKOFF SYSTEM, the SONNENBOERN-BERGER SYSTEM, the MEDIAN SYSTEM and the CUMULATIVE SYSTEM.

EQUIPMENT – Players are responsible for providing sets, boards and clocks and pen or pencil for writing game notation. Limited numbers of sets, boards and clocks will be available for those without necessary equipment. Sets, boards and clocks will be on sale at the tournament.

SPONSORS – Each school must have either a sponsor or parent present. There will be a sponsors and parents meeting during round one.
